

SUMMER FOURSOMES CUP

Format

Partners to be drawn, one high and one low.

Open competition - no qualification needed.

All rounds, including the Final, shall be over 18 holes.

Four weeks shall be allowed for the 1st and subsequent rounds. The first round shall close four weeks from the Monday after the draw is posted on the Notice Board, which should be on or before the previous Wednesday. The closing day for each round shall be on a Monday.

The higher combined handicap pair should contact the lower combined handicap pair within 7 days of the commencement of the round. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.

If a round is not played within the stipulated time, the players offering the most dates should be given a walkover.

In the event of a player going on holiday, she should notify the Steward. Extensions can be given for the final if necessary.

In the event of one partner retiring before the first round is played, a substitute in the correct handicap group may be allowed.

Players in the final round can have a referee arranged by the Steward who is usually the previous year's Captain.
